



FIRST COMMANDMENT:

Love God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit more than you love anything in the whole wide world, more than Mommy and Daddy, and more than any toy or anything you love.

SECOND COMMANDMENT:

Nothing in all the world is more important than God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit. They are more important than Mommy and Daddy, and anything else in all of the world.

THIRD COMMANDMENT:

When you say God's name or Jesus's name, always say it with love and honor. God and Jesus have holy names. Never yell their names out loud when you are angry.

FOURTH COMMANDMENT:

One day a week you need to rest and give thanks to God and his Son, Jesus. For six days we can do chores, like when you clean up your toys, or Mommy/Daddy washes the clothes. But one day out of the week we should not work. We should go to church and give thanks to God, Jesus, and his Holy Spirit. This is called the Sabbath Day.

FIFTH COMMANDMENT

Always love and respect Mommy and Daddy. You show respect to your parents when you listen and then obey what you are told to do.

SIXTH COMMANDMENT:

Never hurt anyone by what you say or what you do. Do not yell or be bossy. Never hit, bite, or push anyone.

SEVENTH COMMANDMENT:

Always be loving toward your family. Family is forever.

EIGHTH COMMANDMENT:

Do not take anything that is not yours unless you ask for permission first. If you take something that is not yours without asking, that is stealing.

NINTH COMMANDMENT:

Never tell a lie. Always tell the truth. Always be honest. Lying is a sin. A lie can hurt someone's feelings. If you lie, it hurts Jesus's feelings (Regarding Rahab, dishonesty is never condoned in scripture. Rahab told a noble lie when dealing with sinful men — Joshua 2:4-7).

TENTH COMMANDMENT:

Give thanks for everything you have. Do not want something someone else has so much that you are not thankful for what God and Jesus have given you.
